



Welcome to Bloomingdale Free Public Library's Summer Reading Program!

How does it work?

The program begins Monday, June 24th and runs through Friday, August 16th. Registration is available as of June 24th, online or in person at the library. If you register online, you must stop by the library to pick up your Reading Log. **Participants registered by Saturday, 6/29 at 1pm will be entered into a special drawing.**

Each circle in your reading log represents 20 minutes of reading/activity. Use the included stickers to keep track of each session. Eligible activities include:

- 20 minutes of reading, listening to a story read out loud, or listening to an audiobook
- Writing an original story
- Making a recipe found in a cookbook
- Doing a craft (pick one up at the library!)
- Playing a game, like a card or board game
- Doing an outdoor activity (walking, biking, hiking, swimming)

Once you have completed 5 (five) 20-minute sessions, come to the library for an official stamp and one prize from our prize box. In addition, you will receive 1 (one) entry into our Grand Prize Raffle.

Registered participants can earn additional raffle tickets by attending Library programs throughout the summer. Registration for programs will open two weeks prior. Prizes will be raffled off at our Celebration Party on August 16th (Attendance at the party not required, but highly encouraged! Winners will be contacted by phone if not available to attend that day.)
